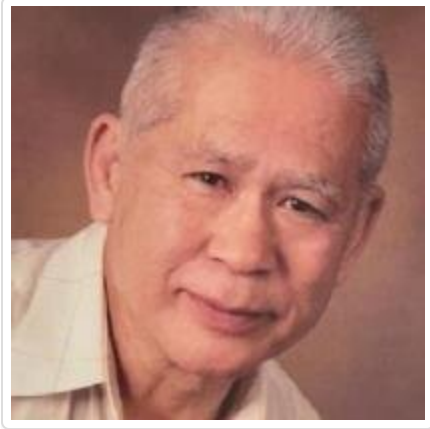




Tadashi Murakami

TSgt Murakami was awarded Good Conduct Medal; Army of Occupation Medal with Japanese Clasp; National Defense Service Medal; Korean Service Medal; United Nations Service Medal; and Marksman Badge with Carbine Bar with Rifle Bar. After returning to America, Tad received a Masters in physical education from Ithaca College and enjoyed wrestling, judo, karate, and archery. He was a physical education teacher and Distribution Supervisor at Crouse Hospital before retiring in 2003 after 28 years of service. He was also a Reiki Master and healer.
